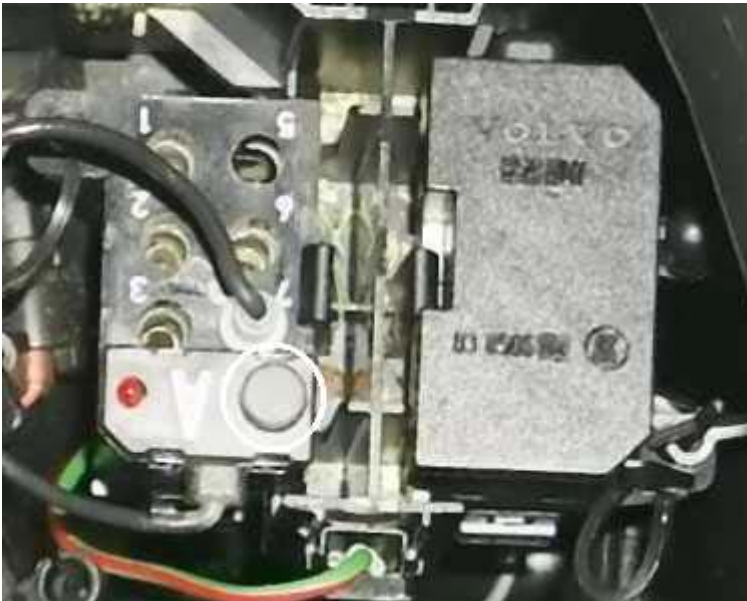


How to get the actual mileage from the 1993—1995 Volvo 850

1. With the car off, open the hood and pull the cap off the OBD-I, A (left side) adapter.



2. Remove the jumper wire from the cap and Jump #7.



3. Go in the car and DO NOT START IT. Turn the car on, II position.
4. Go back under the hood and push the button 5 times. Each time you press the button, the red light next to it will light up. Each time you release the button the light will go out. After you let it go the last time, wait a few seconds and the red light will come back on and stay on.
5. While the light is still on, push the button 1 time. Wait a few seconds until the red light comes back on.
6. While the light is on, push the button 1 time. Wait a few seconds until the red light comes back on.
7. While the light is on, push the button 2 times. Each time you push it, it will light up.
NOTE: Wait a few seconds and the red light will start to blink off your mileage. It will blink for each digit of the mileage and then go off for a few seconds and blink the first 3 mileage digits.
EXAMPLE: 2 blinks, 3 blinks, 10 blinks = 230,***.
8. After you get the third digit, repeat steps 4, 5, 6. When the light comes back on the third time, only press the button 1 time.
NOTE: This time the computer will give you the last 3 digits.
EXAMPLE: 4 blinks, 1 blink, 8 blinks = ***,418. In the example here, the car has 230,418 miles.
9. After you get the mileage, turn the ignition off.
10. Remove the jump wire and put the cap back on.
